Everyone can agree that family time is one of the best — and most important — part of the holidays.

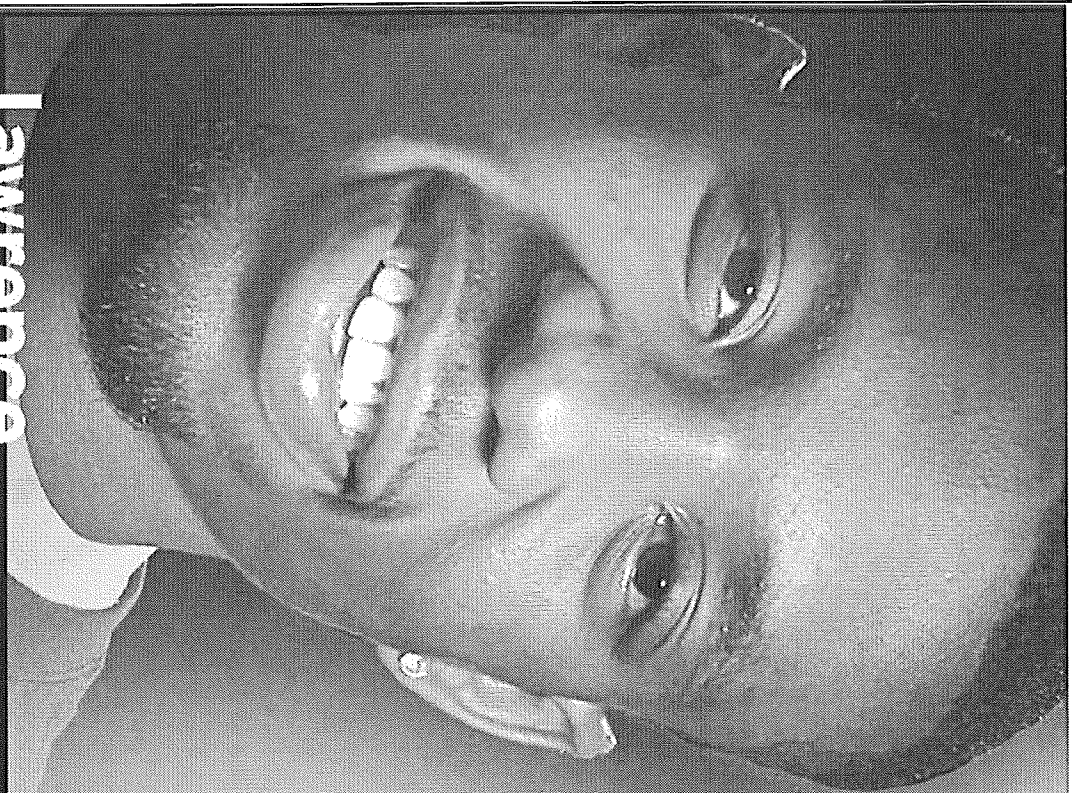

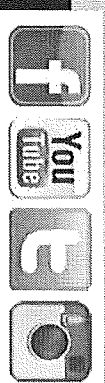
